**7:00 PM** - Meeting was Called to Order by Council Chair Howard Stern.

Treasurer's Report – Terry Foley reported the account balance is \$5,884.

**7:02 PM -** Police Report – Assistant Chief David Dickey presented the latest 28-day Ventura Police Crime Map – new reporting based on NIBRS statistics. There were 7 assault offenses; 9 property crimes; 26 society crimes for a total Group A crimes of 42 vs. 51 crimes last month. There were also few complaints reported during the 4<sup>th</sup> of July holiday in Pierpont however, the rest of the City did not fare too well as overall there were 12 citations for fireworks.

State Parks Update - Tyson Butzke reported the following:

- Recently lost 6 control staff so they have limited resources.
- The X Games are starting next weekend and they expect a much more manageable crowd than the recent Strawberry Festival. The Park will have a shuttle stop for parking.
- A new State Parks Manager, Dina Beldmar was recently appointed,

She presented a tentative timeline that showed hopefully starting at the end of September.

<u>STVR</u>- Terry Foley had no update other than to report that the City' legal department is still aiming to present to the Council a new STVR ordinance by the end of 2023.

<u>Beach</u>- Kaycee Krieg reported that Beach Clean-Up event did happen although she will consider rescheduling the July clean up next year to occur the Saturday after July 4<sup>th</sup>. The next Beach- Clean Up is scheduled on August 5,

Website/PR- Steve Holanov did not have any update to report.

<u>Seaward Beautification</u> - Dan Roundtree reported that there are only a few businesses left to join in the Light up Lower Seaward campaign. There were over 100 new succulents planted in the median on Pierpont.
